

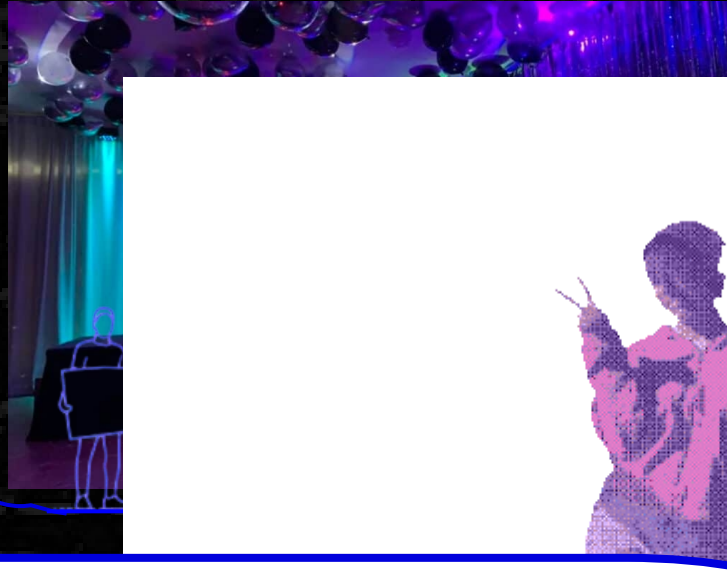

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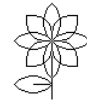
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What is Permacomputing

- “**permacomputing** is both a concept and a community of practice oriented around issues of resilience and regenerativity in computer and network technology”
- **permaculture** is an approach to land management that mimics natural ecosystems
- **monoculture** is rejected. There is no “right” or “best” way to do it
- focus on software AND hardware AND social dimensions

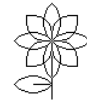




What is Permacomputing

- can look like experiments in minimizing, reusing and revealing existing tech
- or designing tech for disassembly, **descent**, durability/longevity
- projects one could consider permacomputing include:

Collapse OS, Gemini, Low-tech Magazine, and
"small web" publishing ->





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THE ZEN OF SMOL

This depends on the person and context. But if I could provide the "the zen of smol":

- Consider websites as mostly read-only
- Prefer readability
- Build from the principle of least complexity
 - Only use javascript if absolutely necessary
- Leverage semantic HTML
- Leverage RSS feeds
- Target alternative browsers (e.g. netsurf)
- Target terminal browsers (e.g. w3m)
- Support projects without ads or user data

- Lightweight websites (few lazy loaded/dithered photos, no js, little to no css)
- Accessible tech (keepin' it simple)
